- Previously Camera Raw + Photoshop/EL
- Now Lightroom (+ Photoshop)
- Easy move between the two
- "Easy" to use
- Non-destructive
- Lightroom Mobile, Web, Facebook
- Good deal for LR+PS
- KISS!



LR – Software

- LR+PS through Adobe Creative Cloud: \$12/m, \$144/yr
- LR6 \$205
- Elements \$130
- Pros:
 - updates, cheap PS
- Cons:
 - stops when payments stop (but maybe only for PS?)



LR – RAW-JPEG

use RAW!

- better tonal range
- better White Balance adjustments
- set your camera to RAW or RAW+JPEG
- bigger files, need processing
- also, set camera Color Space to AdobeRGB (not sRGB)





Open Lightroom

- from CConly when on-line!
- from desktop shortcut
 always



Screen Layout

- tabs: Library Develop Print
- bottom L: Import Export
- and others



• Where are my images (CR2/NEF/jpg)?

- on C:\drive (My) Pictures folder
- or on separate drive
- regardless of software!
- Ieave them there!

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- LR is non-destructive, links ("import") to a (RAW) file, rather than opening
- linking and editing info in database (Lightroom Catalog.Ircat)
- thumbprints in Lightroom Catalog
 Previews.lrdata
- on C:\Users\Owner\Pictures\Lightroom
 - (or external)
- leave them, only need one Catalog!



LR – file handling

- make backup of RAW files to external drive or Cloud
- make backup of Catalog to external (LR will ask)

move photos using LR!



LR – Library

- Navigator
- Catalog (database)
- Folders (where the images linked to LR are stored)
 - shows "?" when previously imported but now not connected (or renamed)



Publish Services (Facebook)







RAW only or RAW+JPEG?

- if you want both:
 - LR>Edit>Preferences
 - for RAW+JPEG, tick Treat JPEG...

Import Options
Show import dialog when a memory card is detected
Select the "Current/Previous Import" collection during import
Ignore camera-generated folder names when naming folders
Treat JPEG files next to raw files as separate photos



LR – Import

- 1. from previously imported:
 - Import... (Import=Link, not copies!)
 - or Add Folder...
 - select single image or all images in folder
 - add Metadata, Copyright, Keywords
 - to add an image to existing LR folder: synchronise



LR – Import

- 2. from camera/card:
 - This is a Copy from card to computer! + Link to LR Catalog
 - work from left to right!
 - Left: Select source: Camera
 - Centre: All Photos/New Photos
 - Right: To: select location/default




LR – Import

File Handling

- Make a second copy to (e.g. external drive)
- File Renaming
- Apply during Import: Metadata/Copyright/Keyword
- Destination: folder naming
- Import

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- In Library and Develop module: "Select Toolbar Content" to see options
- set Flag, Stars or Colours from the bottom Toolbar
- use "Filters Off" (top-right) to select images with Flags or Ratings



LR – Collections

- What do you want to do with your photos?
- Print, Photobook, Facebook, Web??
- Collect those photos you want in a Collection (links only, no copies!)
- One image can be in more collections
- Edits show in all collections



Vision-driven workflow:

- identify intent
- minimise distractions
- maximise mood
- draw the eye

Make Virtual Copy if required rhc: Create Virtual Copy



- 1. Lens Corrections
 - Remove Chromatic Aberrations
 - Enable Profile Corrections
 - to fix distortion and vignetting
 - SYNC! over more images



- 2. Straighten or Transform
 - to correct horizons, buildings
 - Straighten: Angle drag crop (if req'd) Enter
 - Transform: try Full or Auto, or Guided for more complicated. Use 2, 3 or 4 Guides.
 - "Constrain Crop" or Crop afterwards





- 3. **Crop**
 - crop ratios (incl 1:1)



- 4. Spot Removal
 - to remove blemishes, unwanted objects
 - mostly use *Heal*, Feather=0, Opacity=100;
 - use Clone (=copy) to avoid bleeding
 - line removal: Heal, Feather=0, Opacity=100: click start line, Shift button, click end line.





- 4. Spot Removal
 - need to move? use the Navigator or press the spacebar!
 - tick "Visualise Spots" (or press "A")




<u>Maximise Mood</u>

- 1. White Balance
 - various presets (As Shot, Auto, etc) or manual Temp slider
 - SYNC! over more images



<u>Maximise Mood</u>

- 2. Basics
 - Exposure
 - Highlights Shadows
 - Contrast Clarity
 - Saturation Vibrance
 - Dehaze




Watch the Highlight and Shadow Clipping!

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Maximise Mood


- 3. Tone Curve
 - alternative Contrast etc





Maximise Mood

 4. B&W
 use sliders to change grey tones
 or use Presets (LH panel)







Draw the eye (incl dodge and burn)

- 1. Radial Filter
- 2. Adjustment Tool
- 3. Graduated Filter
 - Will open a new panel with lots of sliders
 - Creates a Mask on the image, then use sliders
 - "Show Selected Mask Overlay" to see selection



<u>Draw the eye</u>

4. Detail>Sharpening – Amount. Use ALT and Masking slider to show what is sharpened

5. Effects>Post-crop vignetting



<u>To go back</u>

- 1. Ctlr-Z
- 2. History panel
- 3. rhc on edit pin Radial Filter, Adj Brush etc, and delete
- 4. turn off/on panels





- 1. To create a JPEG for projection, emails, photobooks etc
 - File>Export or Library>Export button
 - Set various items: sRGB for projection/web
 - Check specific requirements (dimensions, max file size, etc)
 - Add as a new Preset





- 2. To create a TIFF/JPEG for external printing
 - File>Export or Library>Export button
 - Set various items: AdobeRGB for ArtsEdge printing
 - Check specific requirements
 - Add as a new Preset



LR – Printing

Print module

- can use Soft Proofing in Develop
- LH panel: templates
- Page Setup button: set Paper Size (A4, A3 etc) and Portrait/Landscape



LR – Printing

- RH panel:
 - Printer
 - Resolution
 - Sharpening
 - Color Management (Profile, Perceptual/Relative)
- Printer.... button
 - If profile is used, set Printer color management off.





- HDR (Photo>Photo Merge>HDR)
- Stitch (Photo>Photo Merge>Panorama)
- to go to Photoshop:
 - Photo>Edit in Adobe Photoshop
 - Perspective Crop or Transform
 - Clone, Heal, Edit>Fill>Content-Aware Fill
 - Localised Adjustments through Layer Masks
 - in PS: Save, and edited image will appear in LR
