
WORKSHOPS

SUNDAY 8:30am - Steve Wise's workshop is in the Community Hall

SUNDAY 8:00am - Architecture guided shoot workshop with Mark Brierley - venue **Curtin University**

The bus leaves from outside the South Perth Community Hall at 8:00am on Sunday and drops people off at the PF1 carpark at Curtin University. We don't recommend it, but if you choose to self-drive, the Curtin carpark location is shown below.

Pick up is from the same carpark at 10:00am to return to South Perth. Don't be late or you will have to catch an Uber.

SUNDAY 8:30am – Zoo guided shoot workshop with Alex Cearns.

The bus departs from the South Perth Community Hall at 8:30am Sunday, to be ready for entering the Zoo front entrance at 9:00am (20 Labouchere Rd). Pick up is from the same Zoo location at 10:30am. Tickets, included in your conference fee, will be handed out on the bus. Please bring your Proof of Concession to show at entering the Zoo. If you want to go back in the afternoon, make sure you get a return pass!

PHOTOWALKS - Those who turn up, get the shots!

Please note that Photowalks are optional, and finding the location and keeping track of time are your own responsibility. There will be NEPG Guides, please let them know when you arrive, and when you plan to leave. Phone nos quoted are only available during the duration of the walks.

FRIDAY SUNSET Sunset shoot guide locations (the golden hour is 5:17pm, sunset is 5:51pm, the blue hour 6:16pm)



Friday early evening

<u>5.00pm</u>: find your NEPG guide (Mark Greenland – 0407476545) at Mends St Jetty, South Perth. Tell him you're in the group, and EITHER:

A. shoot the city skyline (hopefully lit by late sun). Sunset will be at 5.51pm OR

B. catch 5.15pm ferry to Elizabeth Quay (arrives 5.25pm) and shoot reflective buildings on eastern side of Quay in late light, then the Quay generally and the city lights.

<u>6.30pm</u>: get on ferry back to South Perth

<u>6.40pm</u>: shoot city skyline (with reflections and/or the old Decoy vessel in the foreground?) on a tripod and marvel at how much light there still is!

<u>7.10pm</u>: tell Mark you're packing up and returning to SPCH for Registration, 7.15pm paella and Tony Hewitt's opening address at 8.30pm.

Note: Parking can be a problem at this time of night, so leave plenty of time to walk to and from locations in case you can't park close by. You need to be back at South Perth Community Hall by 7:15pm on Friday. Allow times to buy tickets if taking the ferry.

SATURDAY/SUNDAY DAWN - Dawn shoot guide locations



Saturday/Sunday – Sunrise 6:50am. Find your own breakfast after, and then make sure to be back at the Community Hall by 8:30am on Saturday, and 8:00 or 8:30am on Sunday.

Option 1 – Narrows Bridge

<u>6.15am</u>: meet Cecylia Sylwestrzak (0422000417) at the **Millers Pool Car Park 11** at the southern end of the Narrows Bridge just east of the bridge. Get there by Mill Point Rd through South Perth, or (if you're travelling N or S on the freeway) the Mill Point Rd exit immediately before or after the bridge. Shoot the bridge, the old Brewery building and Kings Park on the northern bank or aim across to the city. Check out the small wetland near the carpark. Discuss with your guide and fellows if going across the bridge to Oldman Park, where there is a waterfall and terraced ponds, as well as the lake and birdlife. Sunrise will be at 6.50am. Later, tell your guide you're going to find breakfast (see attached list of South Perth venues).

Option 2 – Hurlingham Car Park


<u>6.15am</u>: meet at the **Hurlingham Car Park** at the northern (ie river) end of Hurlingham Rd, South Perth (off Mill Point Rd, about a kilometre east of Coode St). This is Sir James Mitchell Park. Find your guide (Mark Greenland – 0407476545) and tell him you're there. Shoot the city, the cyclists and runners, the birds, the lakes, the sun rising at 6.50am over the casino precinct, or the local trees. Later, tell your guide you're going to find breakfast (see attached list of venues).

Option 3 – Claisebrook Inlet

<u>6.15am</u>: meet at the **Mardalup Park Car Park** at the eastern end of Brown St, East Perth. This is Mardalup Park, right by the Claisebrook inlet. Find your guide (Ray Meckenstock – 0409109427) and tell him you're there. Shoot the inlet, Trafalgar Bridge, the buildings, Victoria Gardens at the southern end of the bridge, Optus Stadium, Matagarup Bridge, the old East Perth Power Station, Windan Bridge or the landscaping at Tea Tree Lagoon on the other side of Plain St. Break your fast at the cafes on the inlet, but tell your guide before you leave the location.

NOTES AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

- You will receive a lanyard with <u>name card</u>, showing your allocated presentation and workshop on Sat and Sun (in case you'd forgotten!). Please wear it during the event. People going to the Friday sunset shoot may register afterwards at the Community Hall, on Friday evening or Saturday morning.
- PhotoWest is of course home of the <u>WAPF PrintWest</u> competition. There are several prizes to be won, for Clubs and individuals. Prizes have been generously donated by our Sponsors, and will be awarded during the Saturday dinner. Members can vote for their <u>Member's Choice</u>, which will be announced Sunday morning.



- Major sponsor <u>Team Digital</u> will run its <u>Print Centre</u> again. Just bring your image in on a USB, please have it resized to A4 and they'll do the rest. Limit of one A4 per person. See the separate flyer.

- And we want you to take some exciting photos! As an extra incentive, NEPG will be running a <u>Photo Competition</u>, with as prize a nice print, produced by Fitzgerald Photo Imaging. One photo, taken during the duration of PhotoWest, to be submitted by Sunday, 27 August. See the detail in the separate flyer.
